



## 2019 Feed Appeal Grants Tasmania

This the first year we have offered these grants in Tasmania.

The Feed TAS Appeal's mission is to nourish local communities through our capacity building grants.

Grassroots, Major Projects and Rural grants are given to existing food relief charities who offer meal, food pantry and hamper programs to those experiencing food insecurity in the local community.

Grants are issued for the purchase of staple food and to help improve the service and operational efficiency of organisations.

Purchase of staple food including dairy and meat is provided through a partnership with PFD Foodservice. Grants for cool rooms, refrigeration, food transport, food storage and kitchen equipment were also issued this year to improve the existing services and develop capacity to deliver more.

The grant applications are assessed by state based review panels who allocate 80% of the total funds to charities, with the remaining 20% allocated to FareShare. FareShare is Australia's largest charity kitchens which rescues surplus food and cooks it into nutritious healthy meals which are distributed for free.

The 2019 distribution to FareShare in Tasmania will enable them to distribute more than 3300 of their nutritious meals from their Melbourne kitchen to local food relief agencies throughout Tasmania.
