Rural Schools Grant Program

Maximum Grant Value \$2,000

Guidelines Helping regional/remote schools make a difference in your local community by making sure kids have breakfast and/or lunch to ensure they have the brain power to learn and reach their full potential.

The school's meals program funds costs of food staples to provide nourishing meals or access to meals through our partnership with Eat-Up (click here to see if you are in an eligible area to be supplied by Eat Up)

To be eligible for funding your school must:

- be in the state you are applying for funding in.
- be in a regional/rural community. Click here to see if your postcode is eligible
- In this category we only fund school breakfast or lunch programs including out of school care programs
- If you have an existing meals program, a financial report detailing the costs is required.
- If you are applying to start a program, a financial plan detailing the costs is required
- If you are applying to access the Eat-Up program, which will supply meals to your school -click here to see if your school is in a eligible location (Note the grant money will be allocated to Eat-Up not directly to your school)
- Funding Request up to \$2,000 pa will be accepted

The Schools Meals Grants Program does not Fund:

- funding deficits
- operating costs
- Staff costs
- Transportation and Fuel
- projects outside the state you are applying for funding in (if you have operations in other states, they can apply under that specific state appeal.)
- sponsorship or funding towards a marketing appeal/event or fundraising activities

Additional Information

- Grants up to \$2,000 are allocated each year.
- You will be required to complete an acquittal form at the end of the year detailing the impact of the grant on your school community.
- If you apply to access the Eat Up meals program, Eat Up will be responsible for completing the acquittal
- You will be required to provide testimonials of the impact of the grants.
- Feed Appeal is unable to give funding to individuals or organisations that are not eligible recipients.
- In the interest of supporting many different communities our grants governance committee prefer not to support any one school for more than three consecutive years commencing 2020.
